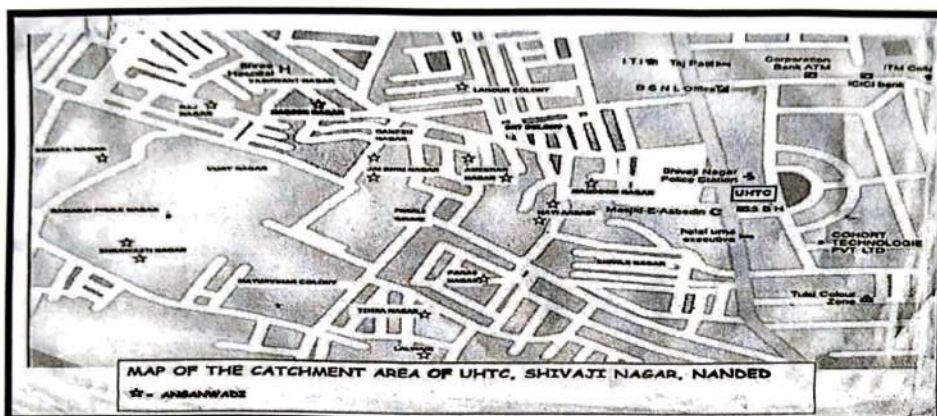

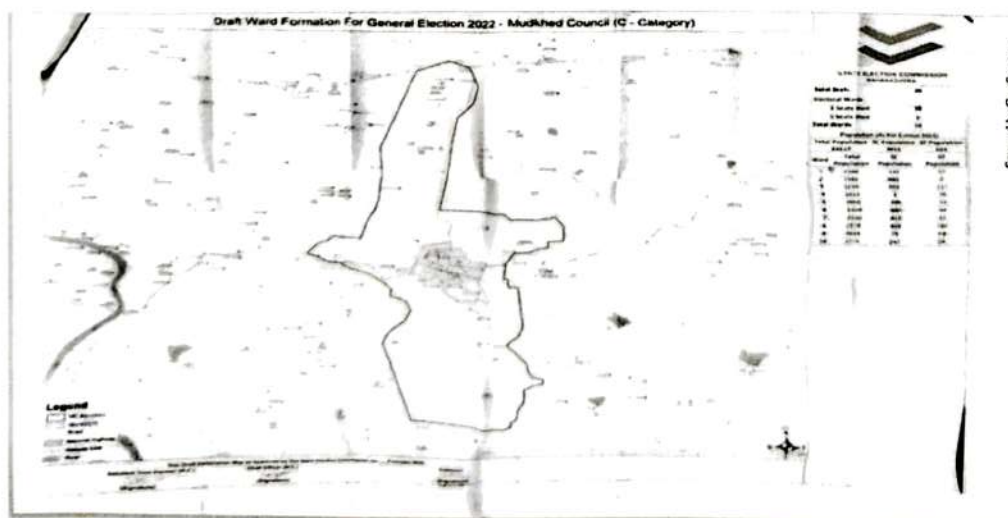
Map of the area catered by UHC:
