Services under UHTC

Curative Services at UHTC

1. Management of Basic Medical Consultation: UHTC provides primary healthcare services, including general medical consultations for common illnesses.
2. Treatment of Acute Illnesses: UHTC offers treatment for various acute illnesses such as respiratory infections, gastrointestinal disorders, fever, skin infections, and minor injuries. They may provide medications, dressings, and other necessary treatments.
3. Immunizations: Here we administer routine immunizations as per the national immunization schedule, including vaccinations for infants, children, and adults. Vaccinations help prevent diseases such as polio, measles, hepatitis, and tetanus.
4. Family Planning Services: UHTC offers family planning services and counseling, including the provision of contraceptives, advice on birth control methods, and guidance on family planning options.
5. Treatment of Chronic Diseases: UHTC also provides ongoing management and treatment for chronic diseases like diabetes, hypertension, asthma, and arthritis.
6. Diagnostic Services: UHTC has basic diagnostic facilities such as laboratory services for blood tests, urine tests.
7. Referrals and Follow-up: We refer patients to higher-level healthcare facilities if specialized care or advanced treatments are required.
8. Basic First Aid: UHTC is equipped to provide basic first aid treatment for common injuries such as cuts, bruises, sprains, strains, and minor burns. Cleaning and dressing of wounds, application of bandages, and pain relief by medications is done.

Preventive and promotive services

Screening for non-communicable diseases (NCDs)

1. Blood Pressure Measurement: High blood pressure (hypertension) is a common NCD and a significant risk factor for heart disease and stroke. Screening involves measuring a person's blood pressure using a sphygmomanometer to identify individuals with elevated or high blood pressure readings. BP monitoring done.
2. Blood Glucose Testing: Blood sugar levels are measured.
3. Body Mass Index (BMI) Calculation: BMI of patients as per need is measured. It is a measure of body fat based on an individual's height and weight. It helps assess

the risk of obesity and related NCDs such as diabetes, cardiovascular diseases, and certain cancers.

4. Tobacco and Alcohol Use Screening: Screening for tobacco and alcohol consumption is important as both are major risk factors for NCD. Referred to higher center if suspected lesions
5. Health Education and Counseling: In addition to screenings, we often provide health education and counseling sessions to raise awareness about NCDs, promote healthy lifestyle practices, and provide guidance on managing risk factors.

Reproductive and Child Health Services

Urban Health and Training Center, Shivaji Nagar provides a range of reproductive and child health services to the urban population. Its centers aim to improve the health and well-being of women and children in urban areas.

1. Antenatal care: UHTC offers antenatal care services to pregnant women, including regular check-ups, monitoring of maternal health, ultrasound examinations, blood tests, and nutritional advice. We also provide tetanus toxoid immunization and iron and folic acid supplementation.
2. Postnatal care: UHTC provides postnatal care services for both mothers and newborns. This includes check-ups, breastfeeding support, immunizations for newborns, and counseling on postpartum care and family planning.
3. Family planning services: UHTC offers various family planning methods, including counseling, provision of contraceptives, and advice on birth spacing. We provide information about different contraceptive methods and help individuals make informed decisions regarding family planning.
4. Immunization services: UHTC plays a vital role in administering immunizations to children as per the national immunization schedule. We provide vaccines against diseases such as polio, measles, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, hepatitis B, and others.
5. Nutrition services: UHTC provides counseling and support for maternal and child nutrition. We offer guidance on appropriate breastfeeding practices, complementary feeding, and nutritional supplements for pregnant women and children.
6. Growth monitoring: UHTC regularly monitors the growth and development of children, including weight, height, and head circumference measurements. This helps identify any signs of malnutrition or growth disorders and enables timely intervention.
7. Management of childhood illnesses: UHTC diagnoses and treats common childhood illnesses such as respiratory infections, diarrhea, fever, and skin infections. We also

refer children to higher-level healthcare facilities if needed.

8. Adolescent health services: UHTC addresses the unique health needs of adolescents, including reproductive health education, counseling, and access to contraceptives. We promote awareness about sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and provide appropriate care and support.

Training Services

1. Provide facility for Community based learning by Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) students
2. Training of intern doctors.
3. Prepare epidemiological, managerial and social case studies.
4. Research and project activities.
5. Skill building of field staff.

Outreach Activities

Community field surveys and visits.

These activities involve going out into the community to collect data, assess health indicators, and interact with community members to gather insights about their health status and the factors that may be influencing it.

Anganwadi visits

Anganwadi visits are part of a community-based program that focuses on early childhood care and development, as well as the overall well-being of mothers and children. They help to provide various services, including nutrition, health check-ups, immunizations, pre-school education, and empowerment of women.

School Health Education Activities

School health education activities are designed to promote the physical, mental, and social well-being of students are conducted. These activities aim to provide students with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to make informed decisions about their health and lead healthy lifestyles.

Organizing health-related days

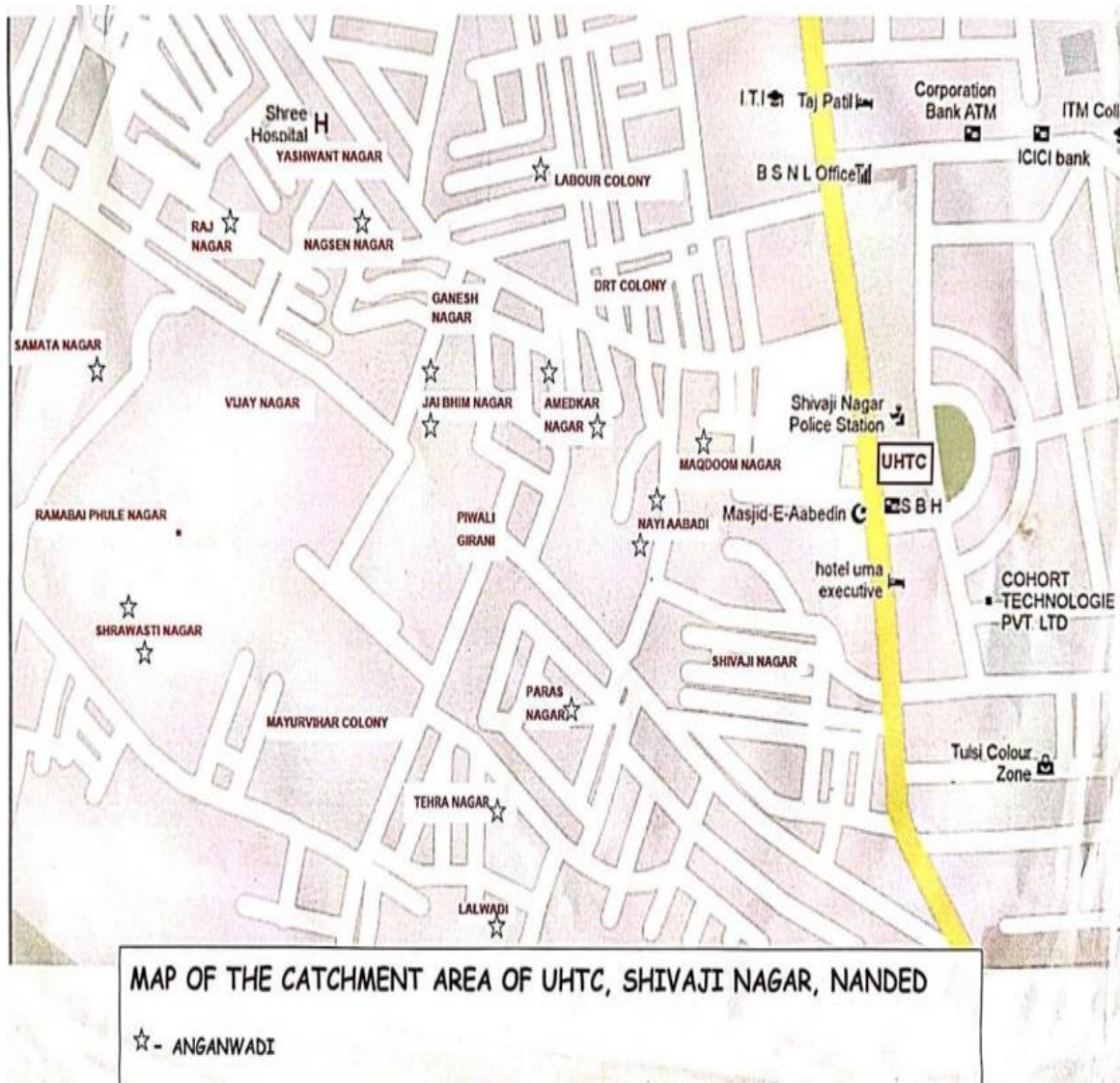

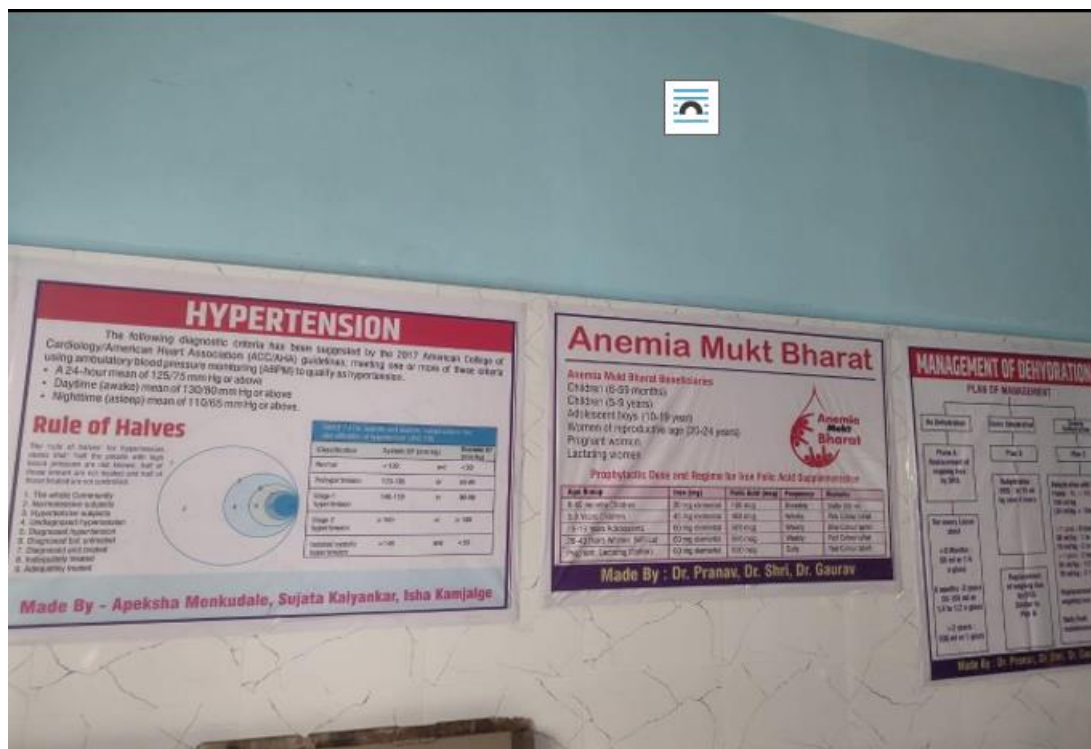

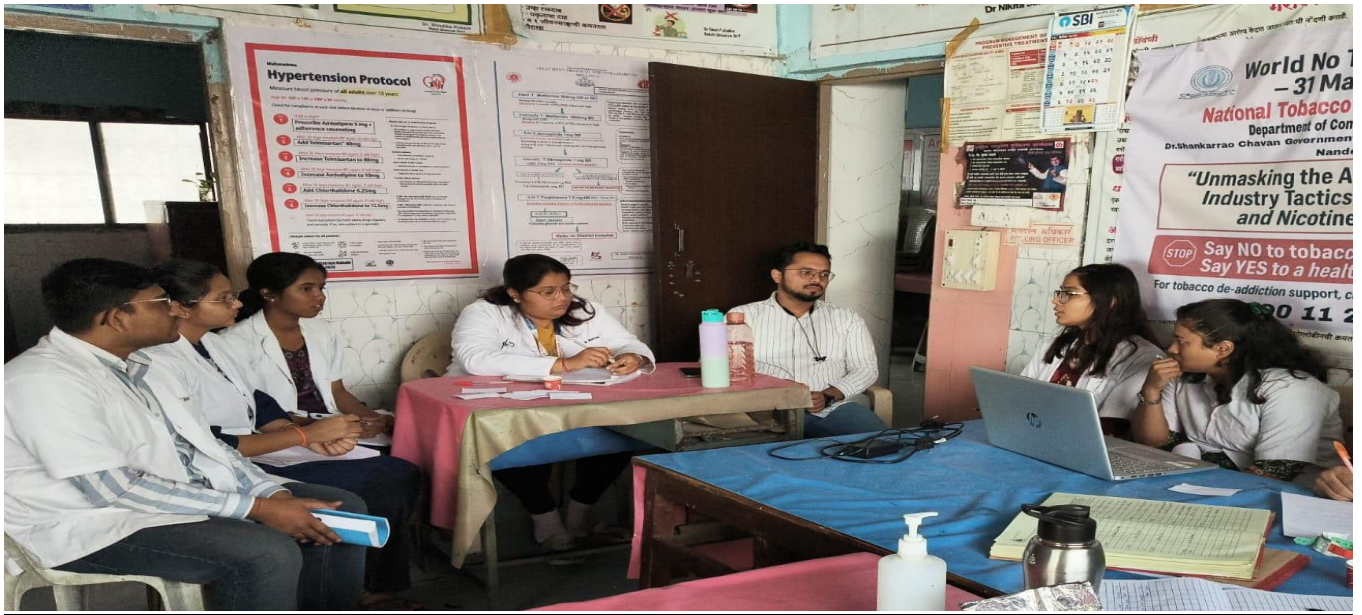
